Praying for other saints should be at the top of our prayer list.
Prayer is simply talking to God. This wonderful privilege of communication that we believers enjoy with our heavenly Father is vital to our Christian life! I am impressed upon with the number of times Paul asks for others to pray for him. Yes, the apostle Paul needed, wanted, desired the intercessory prayers of the saint on his behalf!

Have you ever asked someone to pray for you? Or told someone, "I'm praying for you"? These verses should encourage us to do so. I have a friend that I have never met but we correspond through the mail. She has told me that she has a brightly colored piece of paper on her bulletin board with my name on it and every time she sees it she prays for me. I can't begin to tell you how that has encouraged me time and time again!
In our verse in II Thess. 3:1, Paul not only reminds the saints to pray but he then gives a list of things that the saints should pray about concerning him.
II Thess. 3:1-2 "that the word of the Lord may have" Paul wanted the word of God to run full steam ahead. It is good to be specific in our prayers for others. Paul prayed about specific needs for the saints.
